Shrewsbury Half-Marathon - Calling all Parents!

Back in 2013, the town of Shrewsbury decided to shut its streets for one Sunday in June to hold a half-marathon. That morning a small group of Shrewsbury School runners joined the other competitors to take to the streets and take on the 13-mile challenge. Every year since then the event has grown and as it has done so our own numbers have swelled, with well over 30 Shrewsbury School participants taking part each year. Over the past five years we have raised £26,406 for charities including The Shrewsbury Ark, CRY, The Restart Centre, and Alder Hey Children's Hospital. It is also a wonderful way in which we can bring together the School community in a moment of shared endeavour: last year's 'Team Shrewsbury School' included teaching staff, support staff, pupils, parents and former pupils.



This year's event takes place on Sunday 17th June and entries are now open on the event organiser's website <http://www.shrewsburyhalf.co.uk/>. We would love as many parents as possible to run the race in a Shrewsbury School vest and, likewise, we would love you to consider joining us in raising money for the Andrew Grene Foundation supporting a senior school in Haiti near Cite Soleil, whose population continue to struggle to recover from the devastation caused by the 2010 earthquake.
