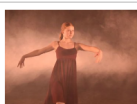
These are fiercely contested races between the fastest runners from each House and very exciting to watch. Spectators are very welcome. Prompt arrival is recommended, as the races won't last long!

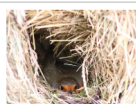


RSSH are Scottish Islands Peaks Race Youth Champions 2019
