They are raising funds for two charities that work in two of the poorest countries in the world. The Andrew Grene Foundation supports a school that is carrying out incredible work with children in Haiti following the devastating earthquake in 2010 and is also transforming the lives of over 1,500 Haitian women through a microfinance project. Medic Malawi funds a hospital in Mtunthama, rural Malawi, together with a clinic for feeding the malnourished, an orphanage for 70 children, and the Shrewsbury School Eye Clinic.
