A message to all parents and guardians from Mr Chris Wain, Head of Futures

I started in post as 'Head of Futures' in April 2019, an exciting role which will include coordinating the delivery of careers advice and guidance for all year groups, to ensure pupils can access relevant support during their time at Shrewsbury School.

As part of this, I am working on a range of Initiatives, events and activities that pupils (and where appropriate parents / guardians) will have access to, in order to complement the existing provision that is in place. These are likely to include, but are not limited to, employer seminars and conferences, mock interviews, industry visits, networking events, work shadowing and career mentoring programmes.
