## Sports Facility Hire

Boasting some of the leading sporting facilities in the country, Shrewsbury is able to cater for a varied range of sports teams / clubs and has hosted a number of national professional teams.

Facilities on offer include:

- Four lane indoor cricket centre including education suite and changing facilities
- Eight outdoor tennis courts in two separate tennis facilities (Gorswen and Porthill Courts)
- Four court squash club including café/bar area
- Three court sports hall, catering for a range of sports including badminton, indoor football, basketball and circuit-training
- Cardiovascular and weights suite
- Twenty-five metre, six lane, deck level swimming pool
- Two full size sand dressed synthetic pitches
- Grass sports pitches, catering for football, cricket and rugby
- Boat club including elite training facilities

As well as the Shrewsbury School Swimming Academy, our pool programme caters to groups from across the local community. We provide swimming lessons to more than a dozen local schools and facilitate usage by community groups such as swimming and triathlon clubs.

Numerous groups make use of the cricket centre, from local club sides to county, regional and national teams. The centre is an outstanding facility that can be enjoyed by players of all ages and abilities.

Other weekly community groups using our facilities every week include hockey, netball and rounders teams, as well as squash and tennis players.
