SCHOLARSHIPS FOR AWARD

A small number of Drama Scholarships are awarded annually. Most scholarships carry fee remission of 10%, although larger awards are sometimes made.

CONDITIONS

Candidates must be registered for entry into the Third Form in September 2022. Please contact the Admissions Office on **01743 280552 (email: admissions@shrewsbury.org.uk)** for a Registration Form if you have not yet registered your son or daughter for Shrewsbury School.

The winner of a Drama Scholarship must also reach a satisfactory standard in Common Entrance, the Academic Scholarship Examination or our 13+ Entrance exams before entering the School.

A Drama Scholar holds their award for five years, provided that their conduct and progress are satisfactory, and that they continue to contribute fully to Drama in the School.

ASSESSMENT

Candidates will be required to attend the evaluation day at Shrewsbury School. Awards will be made based on the following:

- A presentation of two short, contrasting monologues (each monologue should be no more than two minutes long). The chosen monologue(s) may be taken from any published play. Extracts from film scripts and dramatic poems are not appropriate.
 - Candidates may offer a song from the musical theatre repertoire in place of one monologue. Where candidates choose to offer a musical theatre song, they should provide a digital backing track in advance.
 - Candidates may also choose to offer a dance piece in support of their application (in addition to their two prepared pieces).
- An interview with the Director of Drama
- Participation in a group workshop audition.

The reference from the candidate's school and/or other relevant organisations on the application form will be important.

As an alternative, a candidate may be assessed for <u>technical</u> theatre. The candidate should prepare a portfolio evidencing his/her work so far, and would have a practical assessment with the senior theatre technician. He/she would also have an interview with the Director of Drama. The reference from the candidate's school and/or other relevant organisations on the application form will be important.
