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I. School Dress

Please would you ensure that all Sixth Formers have the following items at the start of each term:

- 2 business style suits (navy, grey or black. Suits may be purchased from any retailer or a selection is available at www.waughgroup.co.uk/shrewsbury-school-range All skirts MUST be on or below the knee)
- Or
- 2 jackets and dark formal trousers
- 8 formal shirts/blouses
Shirts may be of any colour except black; stripes or checks are permitted. Button-down collars are not permitted.
- 1 School tie (to be worn with shirts not blouses)
- 2 pairs of black or dark brown polishable formal shoes
Deck and suede shoes are not permitted.
- 1 coat (navy or dark grey, three quarters or full length)

NB This is the only permitted over-garment to be worn with School Dress.
- 1 trunk/large suitcase
- spare name tapes

We recommend that all Sixth Formers have:

- 1 School hoody (for leisure wear only)
- swimming costume/swimming shorts
- 1 scarf
- 1 umbrella
- 2 pullovers or cardigans (single dark colour and v-neck)
- 1 dressing gown and slippers
- 1 overnight travel bag/sports holdall

2. Clothes for Sport

Please ensure all Sixth Formers have the following at the start of term:

- 1 School playing shirt
- 1 House sports top
- 1 pair House socks
- 1 pair School sports socks
- 2 pairs of trainers for general wear, one for indoor use and one for outdoor use
- 1 pair of School field shorts or skort
- 1 pair of School tracksuit bottoms
teamed with either the School weatherlayer jacket or School midlayer fleece.

3. Informal Clothes

We recommend that all Sixth Form pupils have:

- 2 pairs of smart trousers/skirts
- 2 smart polo shirts/tops

Other items of casual clothing might include:

- jeans
- t-shirts
- sweaters
- sweat shirts

NB Please note when selecting informal clothes that storage space in the Houses is limited and it helps enormously if items are both machine washable and suitable for tumble drying.
