In your answers, you should try and include more than one point of view and support these views with argument and evidence. Try to employ both religious and non-religious views whenever possible. You should also offer a justified conclusion.

- 1. 'There is no evidence to suggest the one sacred text is more trustworthy and reliable than any other.' Discuss.
- 2. Discuss the life and teaching of a founder of one of the major world religions. How relevant are these ideas still today?
- 3. Discuss the claim that the case for the resurrection of Jesus has not been made.
- 4. Comment critically on the claim that being religious is not a guarantee of being moral.
- 5. 'There is no place for religion in the post scientific world of the twenty first century'. Discuss.
- 6. The traditional patriarchal view of God is primitive and mythological and needs to be updated for the 21st century.
- 7. 'The most important aspect of religious practice is to worship God.' Do you agree?
- 8. Discuss the view that non-religious approaches to understanding contemporary moral issues are more useful than those associated with traditional religious ideas.
