3. Informal Clothes

- 2 pairs of smart trousers or skirts
- 2 smart polo shirts, blouses or tops

Other items of casual clothing might include:

- jeans
- t-shirts
- sweaters
- sweat shirts

NB Please note when selecting informal clothes that storage space in the Houses is limited and it helps enormously if items are both machine washable and suitable for tumble drying.
